



Developing and Implementing Sustainability-Based Solutions for Bio-Based Plastic Production and Use to Preserve Land and Sea Environmental Quality in Europe

(BIO-PLASTICS EUROPE)

BIO-PLASTICS EUROPE is H2020 funded 4 years project. The project starts **1st of October 2019** and will end 30th of September 2023. The Project will be mainly focused on the development of sustainable strategies and solutions for bio-based plastic products, as well as the development of approaches focused on circular innovation for the whole bio-plastics system. These may be deployed to support policy-making, innovation and technology transfer.

A set of 10 EU countries (Austria, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Lithuania, Poland, Sweden and Spain) plus Malaysia as a non-EU partner, will act as 'living laboratories', undertaking innovative, replicable and locally attuned studies and tests on bioplastics, with a systemic impact at the scale of intervention, to identify possible threats which bioplastics use could pose to the terrestrial and aquatic environment. Possible solutions will be co-designed, co-developed and co-implemented in a trans-disciplinary, multi-stakeholder and participatory process.

Apart from the 21 project partners from EU countries and one partner in Malaysia, **16 European cities** members (of which 10 are national capitals) will be part of the of the "**Network of Historic Cities Against Plastics**" will also be involved in the project, with no EU funding.

The **Kick-Off Meeting** will take part on **28th – 29th of October 2019**, in Hamburg (Empire Riverside Hotel), Germany. Please consult the programme below.
